**WHEREAS**, The Tentative Oneida County Supervisory Plan under County Resolution #92-2021 has been submitted to the Town.


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Town of Stella establish wards conforming to the County Supervisory Plan (see attached) and

Passed this 12th day of October, 2021, by the Town of Stella Town Board.


